Rules for Sailing Southwest Club Championship sponsored by CPMR Limited

The SSW Club Championship will be awarded to the sailing club with the best overall result from the whole series based on the following rules:

- 1. Any club with 3 or more competitors from 2 or more classes will be automatically entered in the Club Event
- 2. Each Entry will assume the best (lowest) score for any 3 competitors so long as they are racing in at least 2 different classes of boat
- 3. Each event may have different mix of competitors and boats representing the club
- 4. The club series will be made of the same 10 events in the Southwest Winter Series and is based on the best results in 50% of the events rounded down to the nearest whole number
- 5. Scores will be allocated based on the club position namely 1,2,3,4 based on their results at individual events
- 6. Ties will be broken as if the events were in a series according the RRS latest edition.
- 7. To represent a club, sailors must be full paid up members

Prizes

A prize fund of £500 will be offered to the top 3 clubs overall sponsored by CPMR Limited (https://www.cpmr.co.uk/).

First Overall £300 Second Overall £125 Third Overall £75

The prize fund is offered to clubs for the advancement of sailing as a sport within the SW region.
